

In May 2023, 57 students were enrolled in the University's CACREP-accredited Clinical Mental Health Counseling (CCMH) program at the Phoenix Campus. Between June 1, 2022, and May 31, 2023, 12 students graduated. Approximately 58 percent of students who were admitted to the CCMH program between September 1, 2018, and August 31, 2019, completed the program within the expected time period. The NCE is required for licensure in Arizona, though students take it outside of the program. Under those circumstances, NBCC does not report results to the institution.

In accordance with CACREP policy, to calculate the job placement and exam pass rate, the University surveyed graduates within 180 days following graduation. Fifty percent (4 out of 8) of graduates responded to the survey. Of the graduates who responded, 100 percent (4 out of 4) reported finding full-time placement in a recognized occupation for which the program prepared them. Non-responses to the survey did not factor into the placement rate. 75 percent (3 out of 4) also reported earning a passing score on the exam necessary for licensure.
