Selection Process

1. The recipients of the scholarships will be selected by the University of Phoenix.

Scholarship Award
Distribution and
Timing

The University of Phoenix will determine and notify the recipients of the scholarships upon validation.

1. The maximum Scholarship award is \$2,000. The Scholarship shall be disbursed as a credit toward the student's tuition payments at a rate of \$185 per course until: (i) the student completes 10 courses, after which a final disbursement of \$150 will be applied toward the eleventh course, thus maximizing the \$2,000 total Scholarship amount, or (ii) two years
