

# Forever a Phoenix® Master's Scholarship September 2023

Summary	All new University of Phoenix bachelor's degree alumni students who (i) apply for and enroll in a University of Phoenix master's degree program; (ii) have an aggregate GPA of 3.25 or higher (on a 4.0 scale) in their University of Phoenix associate's degree; and (iii) apply for this Forever a Phoenix® Master's Scholarship – September 2023 ("Scholarship") prior to the deadline and register and post attendance in their first class between September 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2023 and September 30 <sup>th</sup> , 2023 ("Initial Attendance Window") will have the opportunity to

scholarship, including but not limited to, any promotional materials, internal sites, [www.phoenix.edu](http://www.phoenix.edu), external company sites, press releases and social media.

2. Scholarship award is a non-cash award to recipient's University of Phoenix account as outlined on the scholarship application. Scholarship will be applied to the first credit-bearing class with a start date after the award date. No scholarship funds will be applied to previous classes or currently enrolled classes at the time of scholarship award. No check or other cash monies will be disbursed at any time. No exceptions.

The University of Phoenix treats this tuition scholarship, in the form of a non-cash award, as non-taxable income.   - b. Applicants pursuing stand-alone University of Phoenix courses.
  - c. Applicants pursuing stand-alone University of Phoenix certificates.
  - d. Applicants pursuing a Competency Based Education program.
  - e. Current University of Phoenix students
  - f. Applicants receiving any employer benefits or discounts
  - g. Applicants receiving Military Tuition Rate
  - h. Applicants who do not meet the University of Phoenix eligibility requirements
  - i. Students who enroll and start their first course outside the scholarship window.
