Summary	<p>All new students or students who have been out of attendance for over 365 days who i) apply for and enroll in a University of Phoenix bachelor's degree program; (ii) have three year's work experience and (iii) apply for this Phoenix Bachelor's Scholarship – February 2024 ("Scholarship") prior to the deadline and register and post attendance in their first class between February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024 and February 29<sup>th</sup>, 2024 ("Initial Attendance Window") will receive a scholarship worth up to a maximum of \$1,000 each, distributed over 20 courses.</p> <p>NOTE: Students must begin the admissions application prior to completing this scholarship application.</p>
Application Deadline	<p>The Scholarship application will be made available online on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024. Applications must be completed and submitted online at <a href="http://www.phoenix.edu">www.phoenix.edu</a> by 11:59pm MST February 29<sup>th</sup>, 2024 ("Application Deadline"). Applications submitted after the Application Deadline will not be considered. No exceptions.</p>
Eligibility Criteria	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Applicants currently residing in the United States must meet one of the following requirements: be a legal resident of the United States; have been granted permanent residency; have a valid visa that does not prohibit educational studies; have been granted temporary protected status along with approved Notice of Action issued by Citizen</li> </ol>

	<p>6. Applicant must post attendance to their first bachelor's degree course within the Initial Attendance Window.</p>
Selection Process	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The recipients of the scholarships will be selected by the University of Phoenix.</li> <li>2. It is the applicant's responsibility to submit a complete and signed application along with any required and supporting documentation, which must be received on or before the Application Deadline. The University of Phoenix accepts no responsibility for incomplete applications, applications not in proper form, lost applications, or any other submission in exception to the instructions.</li> <li>3. Scholarship selection shall be made without regard to race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, age, national origin, disability, veteran status, or any other category protected by federal, state, or local law.</li> <li>4. The decision of the University of Phoenix is final and not subject to review.</li> <li>5. Starting on March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024, the University of Phoenix will begin the selection process for eligible qualified students.</li> <li>6. Recipients will be notified no later than April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2024.</li> </ol>
Scholarship Award Distribution and Timing	<p>The University of Phoenix will determine and notify the recipients of the scholarships upon validation.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The maximum scholarship award is \$1,000. The Scholarship shall be disbursed as a credit toward the student's tuition payments at a rate of \$50 per course beginning with the student's first attended course and thereafter for those continuously attended courses in their bachelor's program until: (i) the student has maximized the \$1,000 Scholarship amount, or (ii) two years (730 days) has elapsed from the student's first course start date notwithstanding any approved leave of absence(s), or (iii) the student graduates from their program, whichever comes first. Subsections (i)-(iii) are collectively hereinafter referred to as "Terminating Events".</li> <li>2. Only the applicants selected as Scholarship recipients will be notified by the University of Phoenix.</li> </ol>
Maintenance Requirements	<p>In order to continue disbursement of the scholarship award, applicant must meet the following maintenance requirements:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Applicant must remain in a bachelor's program (all coursework attended must be program applicable courses). Awards will only be</li> </ol>

Applicant must successfully pass each course attempted in accordance with their program's requirements as outlined in the academic catalog for all courses.
