

<p>Summary</p>	<p>All new students or students who have been out of attendance for over 365 days who i) apply for and enroll in a University of Phoenix bachelor's degree program; (ii) have three year's work experience and (iii) apply for this Phoenix Bachelor's Scholarship – October 2024 ("Scholarship") prior to the deadline and register and post attendance in their first class between October 1st, 2024 and October 31st, 2024 ("Initial Attendance Window") will receive a scholarship worth up to a maximum of \$1,000 each, distributed over 20 courses.</p> <p>Students must begin the admissions application prior to completing this scholarship application</p>
<p>Application Deadline</p>	<p>The Scholarship application will be made available online on September 1st, 2024. Applications must be completed and submitted online at www.phoenix.edu by 11:59pm MST October 31st, 2024 ("Application Deadline"). Applications submitted after the Application Deadline will not be considered. No exceptions.</p>
<p>Eligibility Criteria</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Applicants currently residing in the United States must meet one of the following requirements: be a legal resident of the United States; have been granted permanent residency; have a valid visa that does not prohibit educational studies; have been granted temporary protected status along with approved Notice of Action issued by Citizen Immigration Services and verified through CIS Form g-845; or have been granted asylum along with the approved Notice of Action issued by the Citizen Immigration Services. 2. Applicant must meet all admissions requirements of University of Phoenix if selected as a scholarship recipient. 3. Applicant must not be an employee (including full- and part-time faculty)

 - a. Applicants who enroll in a University of Phoenix degree level or program other than what is specifically outlined in the Application's Eligibility Criteria for the scholarship.
 - b. Applicants pursuing stand-alone University of Phoenix courses.
 - c. Applicants pursuing stand-alone University of Phoenix certificates.
 - d. Applicants pursuing a Competency Based Education program.
 - e. Current University of Phoenix Students
 - f. University of Phoenix Alumni
 - g. Applicants receiving any employer benefits or discounts
 - h. Applicants receiving Military Tuition Rate
 - i. Applicants who are receiving the AA Transfer tuition rate
 - j. Applicants who do not meet the University of Phoenix eligibility requirements
 - k. Students who enroll and start their first course outside the scholarship window
 - l. Applicants who have received another University of Phoenix scholarship award in the past two years
6. The Scholarship will automatically terminate if:
 - a. Applicant fails to meet the eligibility requirements
 - b. Recipient is Academically Disqualified, Disqualified for Admission, Scholastically Disqualified, Scholastically Suspended or Expelled as outlined in the University Catalog.
 - c. Recipient is out of attendance on an unapproved leave of absence for more than 35 days.
 - d. Recipient completes their bachelor's degree program.
 - e. Receives the maximum scholarship award
 - f. Two years (730 days) from the start date of recipient's first course notwithstanding any approved leave of absence(s).
7. If recipient has applied for or is receiving Title IV financial aid funding, this scholarship may reduce the recipient's eligibility for Title IV financial aid funding to comply with Title IV regulations. In addition, the recipient must maintain continuous attendance as defined by the University of Phoenix and/or must qualify for a leave of absence to maintain his/her financial aid status.
