Summary	<p>All new students who i) apply for and enroll in a University of Phoenix doctoral degree program; (ii) have three year's work experience and (iii) apply for this Phoenix Doctoral Scholarship – August 2024 ("Scholarship") prior to the deadline and register and post attendance in their first class between August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024, and August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024 ("Initial Attendance Window") will receive a scholarship worth up to a maximum of \$3,000 each, distributed over eight courses.</p> <p>NOTE: Students must begin the admissions application prior to completing this scholarship application.</p>
