

<p>Summary</p>	<p>All new students or students who have been out of attendance for over 365 days who i) apply for and enroll in a University of Phoenix master's degree program; (ii) have three year's work experience and (iii) apply for this Phoenix Master's Winter Scholarship – January 2023 ("Scholarship") prior to the deadline and register and post attendance in their first class between January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023 and January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023 ("Initial Attendance Window") will receive a scholarship up to \$3,000 each.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Students must begin the admissions application prior to completing this scholarship application</p>
<p>Application Deadline</p>	<p>The Scholarship application will be made available online on December 7<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Applications must be completed and submitted online at <a href="http://www.phoenix.edu">www.phoenix.edu</a> by 11:59pm MST January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023 ("Application Deadline"). Applications submitted after the Application Deadline will not be considered. No exceptions.</p>
<p>Eligibility Criteria</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Applicants currently residing in the United States must meet one of the following requirements: be a legal resident of the United States; have been granted permanent residency; have a valid visa that does not prohibit educational studies; have been granted temporary protected status along with approved Notice of Action issued by Citizen Immigration Services and verified through CIS Form g-845; or have been granted asylum along with the approved Notice of Action issued by the Citizen Immigration Services.</li> <li>2. Applicant must meet all admissions requirements of University of Phoenix if selected as a scholarship recipient.</li> <li>3. Applicant must not be an employee (including full- and part-time faculty) or a family member (spouse, dependent child, or domestic partner) of an employee of University of Phoenix or any other affiliate of University of Phoenix, Inc.</li> <li>4. Applicant must apply and be admitted to a University of Phoenix master's degree program.</li> <li>5. Applicant must submit a complete, signed application, together with all supporting documentation by the Application Deadline. The completion of the application form does not create an obligation to award a scholarship to the applicant.</li> </ol>
